



Dear Small Group Leader, (or one to one discipler)

Have you ever wondered if people in your small group (or others you care about) have a clear understanding of the core elements of their Christian faith? Are you confident that they have a solid biblical foundation in the areas of salvation, forgiveness, power over sin and authority and reliability of the Bible? Could they clearly explain what they believe to someone who is seeking answers to core questions about a relationship with God? Do their lives show these principles?

If you're not sure where the people you care about stand on these critical questions, I invite you to one of two training events in January. These will expose you to a process and a tool that will help insure that your small group is clear and confident about what they believe.

The first is ***Accelerated Equipping for Discipling Others*** on **January 17<sup>th</sup>**. This will help people to equip others with one of two tools, *Real Faith or Destined*. This event will clarify the **discipleship process**, as refined by Life Builders, an adult ministry of Campus Crusade. You'll learn why and how to mentor others more effectively.

The second event is called ***Scouting Real Faith*** on **January 31<sup>st</sup>**. This will be a scouting meeting for you and/or individuals or group members. You can scout out the process and tools before you decide to launch it in your group. We'll give you a hands-on demonstration of how this curriculum can work in your small group or one to one.

Both trainings will be taught by Kurt Loosenort, who is a veteran of discipling and training leaders to disciple others. Kurt has worked with Life Builders, an adult discipleship ministry of Campus Crusade for the past 29 years. Kurt has become a close friend of mine and of Ada Bible Church in recent months. He takes great joy in helping us as a church be better equipped in understanding, applying, and sharing our faith with confidence and clarity.
